

**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF FINALISED ABERDEEN CITY AND
ABERDEENSHIRE (EXCLUDING THE CAIRNGORMS NATIONAL
PARK AREA) STRUCTURE PLAN**

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997

The Aberdeen City and Shire Strategic Development Planning Authority has submitted the above named structure plan to Scottish Ministers for their approval on behalf of Aberdeen City and Aberdeenshire Councils. The plan relates to the whole of Aberdeen City and Aberdeenshire excluding the Cairngorms National Park.
